

Transfer Credit

Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College (ABAC) welcomes applications from students who wish to transfer to ABAC from other institutions. Detailed in Section 8 of “Admissions,” transfer students must provide ABAC with official academic transcripts from all former schools.

All academic credit attempted at regionally-accredited institutions will be reviewed by the College. The institution retains the right to determine the amount of credit to be awarded. Credit awarded must be appropriately related to a student's educational program at ABAC. ABAC grants transfer credit for courses taken at regionally-accredited institutions. ABAC gives credit for Technical Colleges with SACSCOC accreditation.

If students have completed the General Education core requirements at a University System of Georgia institution, they do not have to meet ABAC’s general education requirements as long as they maintain the same major in transfer. A change of major may affect areas of the core. Transfer courses will be assigned ABAC course numbers if the content and level are equivalent. For those courses without an exact equivalent, the course will be assigned a number based on the level of the class. All 1000-level will transfer as 1XXX, 2000 level as 2XXX, etc. If these courses are not marked as core, the academic advisor will determine how to use these courses in the program of study. Students transferring United States History (HIST 2111/2112) or American Government (POLS 1101) from an institution outside Georgia must take a Georgia exemption exam.

Information regarding ABAC’s acceptance of Advanced Placement (AP) & International Baccalaureate (IB) credit is available in the College Catalog and on the website.

Students may review the section “Residency Requirements for Graduation” in the College Catalog and on the website for details on the resident credit required at ABAC.

After acceptance to ABAC, students who have official transcripts submitted by former schools will access their academic transcripts in Banner Web to see the courses and credit hours accepted for transfer.
